



Terms of Reference Adjunct Professor 2024

1. Background

The vision of Universitas Diponegoro (UNDIP) to become a World Class Research University, could be seen in the assessment of academic reputation as one of the benchmarks for world-class university rankings and international recognition. Academic reputation is measured by how far UNDIP is known by international level institutions through UNDIP's teaching and research staff. International recognition of the academy reputation of the Universitas Diponegoro can be implemented by inviting international researchers from other countries to partner with UNDIP researchers.

Research, as one of the main elements of the three main activities including teaching and community service (Higher Education Tri Dharma), is the benchmark for making short-term and long-term strategies at UNDIP in order to increase UNDIP's international ranking. In order to support the improvement of the quality of research that supports UNDIP's international level ranking, it is important for the Adjunct Professor program to be held at UNDIP. Through this activity, UNDIP can also increase its international reputation through teaching and research collaborations with foreign Professors.

Adjunct Professor is defined as an international academic with a professor title who is willing to become a contract and affiliated lecturer for 1 year at Universitas Diponegoro. Adjunct Professor program is an UNDIP reliable program to improve quality and quantity in various academic fields of research, teaching and innovation. This program starts with improving the quality of research, teaching, and innovation within the faculty. Through *Adjunct Professor*, the number of foreign lecturers at UNDIP can be increased by inviting foreign parties as lecturers (guest lecturers, examiners, supervisors), developing cooperation in teaching and collaborative research which will produce publications.

2. Objectives

The objectives of Adjunct Professor activities include:

1. increase the number of foreign lecturers;
2. increase the quality and quantity of UNDIP-collaborative research;
3. increase the number of publications in reputable international journals;
4. improving KPI achievements of PTNBH for collaboration with international level, universities, and international accreditation;
5. expand international networks.

3. Mechanism and Design

The Adjunct Professor program activities are carried out through several stages, namely (1) program socialization to all Faculties/Schools/Research Centers at UNDIP; (2) collection and selection of proposal eligibility; (3) implementation of activities; (4) monitoring and evaluation activities are carried out to ensure the quality of the research process and output is in accordance with the targets stated in the proposal.

The Activities to do during Adjunct Professor program are

1. Becoming a guest lecturer or guest researcher at lectures, seminars, or training;
2. Carrying out joint supervision and or external examination;
3. Being a resource person for manuscript clinics or providing supervision through improving the quality of articles (fine tuning);
4. Making publications in reputable international journals indexed by Scopus or Web of Science;
5. Carrying out cooperation initiatives as outlined in LoI, LoA, MoA, MoU or other Cooperation Certificates;
6. Assisting journal development and maintenance at UNDIP.

Requirements for Adjunct Professor:

1. Have Doctoral degree
2. Have a Scopus H-index of at least 5 for the Social Humanities field and a minimum of 15 for the Science field
3. Willing to comply with the applicable laws and regulations in Indonesia.
4. Must be affiliated with foreign universities/institutions (non-Indonesia).
5. Willing to add Universitas Diponegoro affiliation to publications produced during the contract period.

Activities Method

Adjunct Professor activities are carried out online and with a minimum of 10 days of offline activities at Universitas Diponegoro.

5. Activity Output

The outputs that must be produced by program recipients according to the type of activity, namely:

1. Articles published in reputable international journals indexed by Scopus or Web of Science with UNDIP as an affiliate:
SJR \geq 1 = 1 article; or
1 > SJR > 0.5 = 2 articles; or
0.5 > SJR > 0.1 = 3 articles
2. The draft cooperation initiation as outlined in the LoI, LoA, MoA, MoU and other cooperation certificates.

6. Funding and Budget

Funding sources come from the budget allocation for the 2023-2024 WCU program with a maximum funding of IDR 100,000,000.00 per Adjunct Professor participant provided that:

- a. 50% of the fund for implementing activities, namely 50% x Rp. 100,000,000.00 in the amount of Rp. 50,000,000.00 (fifty million rupiah) is allocated as partner incentives
- b. 50% of the fund for implementing activities, namely 50% x Rp. 100,000,000.00 in the amount of Rp. 50,000,000.00 (fifty million rupiah) is allocated as a fund for implementing offline activities in Indonesia and fee of companion in the amount of Rp. 5,000,000.00 (five million rupiah)
- c. Cost components and supporting documents for adjunct professor financing:

(i) Adjunct professor incentive

Is an incentive financing for partners as adjunct professors, supporters in the form of articles submitted or published in Scopus indexed international journals or web of science with UNDIP as an affiliate

(ii) Transportation

This is transportation financing from the partner's domicile to Diponegoro University (round trip), supporting documents in the form of e-tickets, receipts, boarding passes.

(iii) Accommodation

is the cost of accommodation for adjunct professor partners while carrying out adjunct professor activities offline in Indonesia, supporting documents in the form of invoices

(iv) Activity Implementation Cost

This is the cost of carrying out adjunct professor activities offline in Indonesia such as manuscript clinic activities, general stadiums, mini seminars, field work, guest lecturers etc., supporting documents in the form of invoices.

(v) Companion Fee

This is the incentive cost for companion
